

## Tour Cost: SG \$4299

**Included Costs:** Airfare; airport taxes; accommodations in Israel based on twin sharing; all meals while in Israel (buffet breakfasts, lunches near sites, and buffet dinners); entrance fees to all specified sites; Israeli departure fees; visas for Israel; roundtrip airport transfers in (if arriving/departing with main tour group); study guide for sites visited; services of English speaking guides; air-conditioned buses; porterage of one piece of luggage; and all tips (guides, drivers, hotels, meals, and porters).

**Excluded Costs:** Fees to obtain/renew a passport; airline fuel surcharge; medical and travel insurance; extra beverages with meals; Jordan River baptismal fee; single supplement; personal expenses, and personal travel before or after the tour. Citizens of some countries may be assessed visa fees for Israel and will be asked to pay the difference in cost (no charge for citizens of Singapore).

**Luggage:** Each passenger coming from Singapore is allowed only one piece of checked luggage weighing up to 20 kilograms plus one piece of hand luggage not exceeding 17" x 14" x 8". A fee will be assessed for more than one piece of checked luggage.

**What to Bring:** Bible, notebook, hat or umbrella for sun protection, sun screen lotion, sturdy walking shoes, casual clothing for touring, long trousers or skirt for certain religious sites, water shoes for the Dead Sea beach, flashlight, skin lotion, personal toiletries, swimsuit, camera, and spending money.

**Documentation:** Participants must ensure that their passports are valid for at least six (6) months after the stay in Israel. All necessary documents for visas must be submitted to Ms. Yoon Chyi at Cruise and Tours on or before 10 March, 2010.

**Additional Rooming Options:** While efforts will be made to find a roommate for those traveling without a partner, it is not guaranteed. A single supplement is an additional cost of US \$766. There is no reduction of cost if three adults (including children ages 12+) share a room.

**Children:** Because this tour has an educational emphasis, it is not recommended for children under the age of twelve.

**East Asia School of Theology (EAST) Class Credit:** Those who wish to obtain four hours of EAST credit can do so. Homework must be completed prior to the trip to enhance the learning experience. Questions about homework requirements can be sent to [studytour@east.edu.sg](mailto:studytour@east.edu.sg). Those who indicate on the trip registration form that they wish to receive class credit will receive instructions how to register for the class. EAST tuition fees will be assessed upon class registration. The cost of the textbook is not included in the tuition fee.

**Pre-trip Sessions and Orientation:** Since this is an educational tour there will be three pre-trip sessions at EAST prior to the trip for both those taking the class for credit and those going for personal enrichment. These sessions will provide biblical and cultural contexts of many sites/regions to be visited. A fourth and final orientation will occur about two weeks before departure to provide additional information about the schedule, flights, clothing, and security, or other questions participants may have.

**Travelers not Originating from Singapore and/or Using Frequent Flyer Miles:** Participants not coming with the group from Singapore and/or those using frequent flyer miles will need to make their own flight arrangements. However, Cruise and Tours can assist participants originating from other countries with flight arrangements. Contact Ms. Yoon Chyi at Cruise and Tours for more information. The land package cost is SGD 2999.00 (see details below).

Those not traveling with the group should make arrangements to arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport (Tel Aviv, Israel) prior to 9 a.m. on May 11, 2010 and depart after 3 p.m. on May 21, 2010. Accommodations and airport transfers for those not traveling with the main group can be arranged at an additional cost. To make these arrangements please contact Ms. Yoon Chyi at Cruise and Tours.

**Minimum Number of Participants:** The costs of the trip are based upon a minimum of 25 participants.
