He did it by getting his teeth into Tomoki's cheek! Imagine how Tomoki was shocked and painful.... At the night, before going to bed, Tomoki prayed for Ryosuke not to do bad things to him. But he didn't seem to have an idea that he first did a bad thing to Ryosuke by pushing him badly.... Eri and I are praying that these kids will learn more to be nice to each other.
